Appropriate Behavior - Policy Guidelines

To ensure that CTK youth ministry experiences are the most enjoyable and safest for everyone involved, it is necessary to address appropriate behavior, stated in the following guidelines:

1. Think of safety first in all situations.
2. Following the lesson taught in Matthew 7:12, "So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you," please respect others and their belongings. Physical and verbal abuse, excessive touching, and theft will not be tolerated.
3. Please respect your bodies. Avoid substance abuse. Alcohol, tobacco, and drug use will not be tolerated, nor will it be tolerated if you come to an event under the influence of any such substances.
4. Dress appropriately for the planned activity. Please do not wear garments which advertise alcohol or tobacco or garments with inappropriate pictures or slogans.
5. Only "G" and "PG" videos and appropriate music (no profanity) will be played at youth events.
6. Stay within the activity area until dismissed for accountability purposes and so you can be located easily.
7. Adult drivers will be used on trips, not student drivers.
8. In the event of a retreat or lock-in, boys and girls will sleep in separate areas.
9. All facilities used during a youth activity must be left in the condition they were before the activity or in better condition.
10. Have a great time!

Possible Consequences

If you chose to act against the above recommendations, action will have to be take. Be prepared for any of the following consequences:

- Your inappropriate behavior will be discussed with you.
- Your parents will be notified of your behavior.
- Your parents will be asked to pick you up early form the event, or you will be sent home at your family's expense.
